**Subject: Requesting to initiate suo moto proceedings in the case of detention of protesting student activist from Tripura Student Union and Student Federation of India on July 4, 2024 by Agartala Police.**

We are writing to you to bring to your kind attention that on July 4, 2024 student activist of Tripura Student Union (TSU) and Student Federation of India (SFI) staged a protest in front of Shiksha Bhawan, Agartala. The students demonstrated against school mergers in Tripura and attack on eight girl students during a protest, UGC-NET, school Consolidation in Tripura, Failed Vidyajyoti Scheme, Teacher Shortage and Delay in providing textbooks to the students.

Agartala police obstructed the protestors when they started their procession from Chatra Yuva Bhawan to Shiksha Bhawan, Agartala, Tripura. Then detained SFI state secretary Sandeepan Deb and other protesting students.

We believe detention of the protesting student activist is an act of reprisal against the activist as Human Rights Defenders.

We urgently appeal to you to exercise Section 12 (a) of the Protection of Human Rights (Amendment) Act, 2019, and take *suo moto* cognizance of this incident and initiate an independent inquiry through NHRC's investigation wing. We hope and expect that the NHRC will intervene in this case impartially and in a time bound manner.
